

Timetable of Accommodation Process Current Foreign Students 2020

1 st May	First day of the Accommodation Application Process for Current Foreign Students.
from 1 st May to 22 nd May	Students are obligated to register on the <u>www.dormitory.sspw.pl</u> website and submit their applications online to the Accommodation System. Registration failure may result in dormitory room application refusal. The Accommodation Committee for PhD will then check correctness of data in the Accommodation System.
from 1 st May to 11 th May	Married couples who wish to live together are obligated to submit applications in the Accommodation System with official proof of marriage.
23 rd May	List of people both approved and on the reserve list in the Accommodation Process are posted on the notice boards. Admissions of lists from rector/university chancellor (based on appeal letters).
27 th May	End of admissions of lists from the Rector (based on appeal letters).
until 29 th May	Publishing of the provisional decisions by the Faculty Accommodation Committee in the Accommodation System.
from 23 th May to 30 th May	Students' Applications in the Accommodation System room preference Declarations.
until 7 th June	Publishing of the provisional decisions by the Faculty Accommodation Committee in the Accommodation System.
from 7 th June to 12 th June	Admissions of lists from rector/university chancellor (regarding rooms given).
until 15 th June	Publishing of the final decisions (signed by Deans) by the Faculty Accommodation Committee in the Accommodation System.
until 19 th June	Deans forwarding lists of given rooms to the Bank of Places.
21 st August	Final deadline of paying the deposit for the formerly occupied room in WUT's dormitory. Not paying the deposit equals with resignation from WUT's accommodation. The end of Accommodation Process for PhD Students.
28 th September	First day of accommodating students in dormitories.
7 th October	Lay day when the referrals to WUT's dormitories are valid. Students who will not turn up in the allocated rooms by then, will lose those places as a consequence.
